

## LICENSING ACT 2003 NOTICE OF APPLICATION FOR A REVIEW OF A PREMISES LICENCE

Notice is given that Hounslow Council has received an application for Review of the Premises Licence at the above address under the Licensing Act 2003.

## The grounds of the application for review are:

- The grounds for review are concerning the management of the premises, consistent alleged breaches of licence conditions and complaints received by the Council alleging Anti-Social Behaviour associated to the premises.
- The objective of the review is to put in place a series of conditions to improve the management of the premises and promote the Licensing Act objectives. Proposed conditions relate to CCTV, SIA Door Supervisors log book, Incident (complaints) log and Staff Training records.

Any interested party or responsible authority wishing to make representations regarding this application may do so by writing to the Regeneration, Economic Development & Environment Department – Licensing, Civic Centre, Lampton Road, Hounslow, TW3 4DN. Representations must be received no later than 18<sup>th</sup> January 2017.
